# COOL SEASON LAWN PROGRAM

## Cycle 1

*February – Mid March*

Fertilizer for top growth to push out winter damage, Pre-emerge to prevent weed development, and Post-emerge for any existing weeds.

## Cycle 2

*Mid March – End of April*

Fertilizer to feed and promote healthy color, Pre-emerge to prevent weed development, and Post-emerge for any existing weeds.

## Cycle 3

*May – Early June*

Iron based fertilizer with micro nutrients to help with turf stress and color, Post-emerge for existing weeds, Last round of Pre-emerge, and Insecticide.

## Cycle 4

*Early June – Mid July*

Iron based fertilizer with micro nutrients to help with turf stress and color, Post-emerge for existing weeds, and Insecticide.

## Cycle 5

*Mid July – Late August*

Iron based fertilizer with micro nutrients to help with turf stress and color, Post-emerge for existing weeds with a focus on grassy weeds.

## Cycle 6

*September – End of October*

Granular Fertilizer to help with both color, top growth, and root development (Weed Control only applied by request because it's time to seed).

## Cycle 7

*November – Mid December*

Granular Fertilizer to help build the root system and to help with winter stress (Weed Control only applied by request because seed is still developing).

## Cycle 8

*Mid December – January*

Post-emerge for winter weeds and pH maintenance to help keep the soil pH in a healthy range.
